summer heat waves, long periods of drought, storm precipitation, windstorms

high level of vulnerability - settlement structure is formed in major part by residential areas consisting of prevailingly prefabricated buildings, low construction quality,

poor quality of open spaces

Lack of knowledge and practical examples of options for adaptation and mitigation particular in this kind of residential areas

Low social cohesion and social life of community,

The legislation conditions are not favourable, missing standards







Project goals

to balance the adaptation and mitigation efforts in residential areas with the aim to increase climate resilience, to reduce the carbon footprint health and living comfort for local citizens, greater property protection, saving of financial resources of citizens and municipalities and in higher biodiversity.

what went well


?



- O Preconditions "for succes":
- 1.Political support (but this could change after the election)
- O 2.Excellent knowledge about the topic, needs and about the challenges to be solved – already the preliminary assessments and evaluation, measurement and analyses prior to the preparation of the application
- 3. Partner's consortium excellent cooperation



the barriers



- Uncertainty of different kind (e.g.budget – estimation of costs)
- Local deputies the opposition to the mayor and to the main political support (threats – new elections) – agreement on co-financing
- Difficult administration and decission making internal processes within the Municipality
- High administrative burden
